

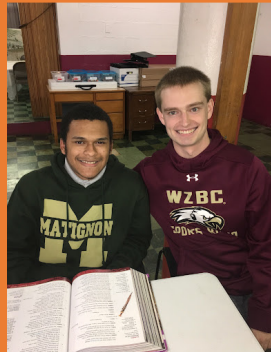
EVkids

Impact Report 2021



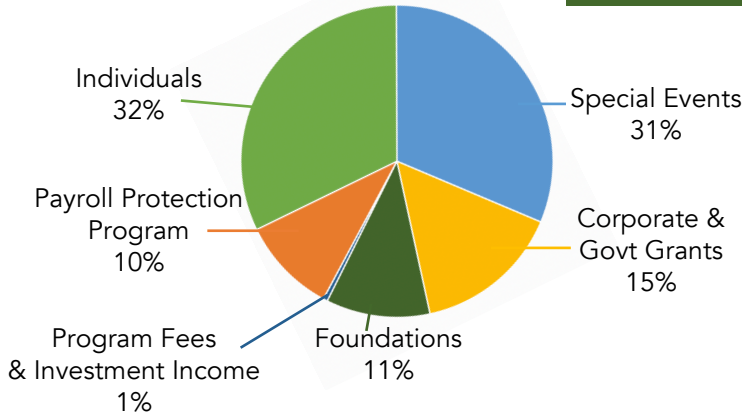

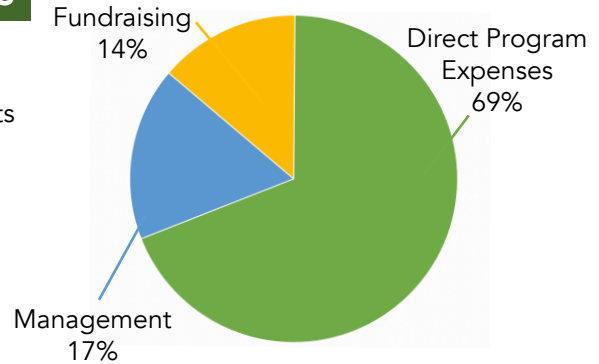
